1 Samuel 22 David left Gath and escaped to the cave of Adullam. When his brothers and his father’s household heard about it, they went down there to him.**2** All those who were in



distress or in debt or discontented gathered around him, and he became their commander. About 400 hundred men were with him. **Scripture Vase 3** From there David went to Mizpah in Moab and said to the king of Moab, “Would you let my father and mother come and stay with you until I learn what God will do for me?” **4** So he left them with the king of Moab, and they stayed with him as long as David was in the stronghold. **5** But the prophet Gad said to David, “Do not stay in the stronghold. Go into the land of Judah.” So, David left and went to the forest of Hereth.

20 But one son of Ahimelek son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped and fled to join David. **21** He told David that Saul had killed the priests of the Lord.**22** Then David said to Abiathar, “That day, when Doeg the Edomite was there, I knew he would be sure to tell Saul. I am responsible for the death of your whole family. **23** Stay with me; don’t be afraid. The man who wants to kill you is trying to kill me too. You will be safe with me.” **Dialogue/Cutscene**
